Dr Monica Gorman is Associate Professor in UCD's School of Agriculture and Food Science. She has developed and coordinates postgraduate Masters programmes for agricultural science graduates who intend to work in farm advisory and agricultural education roles; working in collaboration with Ireland's agricultural knowledge and innovation system. From a family farm in Wicklow she has previously worked in international development in Africa and continues engagement in projects in Kenya and Eritrea. Her research interests include multifunctional agriculture, expanding livelihood opportunities for farm families, gender issues in agriculture and how best to support multi-actor engagement in co-creating innovative responses to the challenges facing agriculture.

Dr. Marion Beecher is currently working with Teagasc as a Research Officer in the Animal & Grassland Research and Innovation Cere in Moorepark. Her research interests include dairy farm labour productivity specifically looking at labour saving technologies, infrastructure, and work organisation including Lean Management as well as evaluating human resource management practices within Irish dairy farm businesses. Prior to this she co-ordinated the Professional Diploma in Dairy Farm Management Programme which involved coordinating the placements of students on approved dairy host farmers for training. She graduated from University College Dublin with a PhD in animal science.

Barbara Bray MBE FIFST is a Registered Nutritionist and food safety consultant driving and delivering food safety and nutrition strategy for food businesses. Her leadership roles have included being Co-Chairman of the Oxford Farming Conference and representing the Private Sector Mechanism in interventions at the UN Committee for Food Security in Rome. She is also a Fellow and committee member of IFST and a trustee of the Nutrition Society. In 2017, Barbara was awarded a Nuffield Farming Scholarship and travelled to Singapore, Indonesia, Japan, Israel, UK and USA to study international food and farming systems.

In 2019, Barbara was awarded an MBE in the Queen's Birthday Honours list for her 'Services to Food Nutrition'. Barbara is currently researching diets to protect health of older adults in a doctoral training programme at the Centre for Public Health at Queen's University Belfast.
